The group provides adequate first aid equipment. Leaders may wish to bring their own on camps and activities and this is acceptable. All Group First Aid kits are logged, and a database is kept with expiry dates.

These will be replaced once expired by the GSL. All first aid kits are sealed and once the seal is broken any items used must be reported to the GSL for replacement immediately. The GSL will replenish the used items and re-seal the First Aid Kits

The group now has a defibrillator that is stored at Yarm Road for use when the group is meeting. It must be taken on all day trips and camps, it has a location at Raby to be hung up when you arrive on camp.
