Leaders Attending other Section's Camps & Activities

Sections are responsible for ensuring that they have enough leaders to cover any planned camps or activities. They should use leaders or helpers that are associated to their section first but if needed can ask the wider group for help and support, there may be occasions that leaders wish to attend a camp or activity but priority is always given to leaders from the section who is organising / running the event. leaders cannot attend a camp or activity outside of their section if this is going to increase the cost of the event and the group does not allow leaders to 'pay' to attend such events.

If a leader wishes to attend another sections camp or activity, then they must speak to the section leader to establish if there is a space for them and no additional cost will occur. If a space is available and costs unaffected then with the permission of the section leader, they may attend the camp or activity.

The only exception to this rule is Raby Camps at the Cabin where all leaders are invited to attend all camps on an open invitation, you must tell the section leader that you are attending to allow for food etc. If the section is leaving raby for an outside visit or activity then again priority is given to the section that is camping. Again, please speak to the section leader beforehand.

Some leaders attend other section camps and must bring children to camp. To be fair to them and the group they will pay a reduced camp fee of only £5 per day to cover food costs. They must pay for any external trips while on camp but again ensure a space is available for their child.

Leaders must add their children to all camp forms and paperwork this is a priority
